

revere him, all you descendants of Israel. *R*/



Christ humbled himself. Because of this God greatly exalted him.





I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and life everlasting. Amen.





Refrain: Be - hold, be - hold the wood of the cross, on which is hung our sal - va - tion. O come, let us a - dore.






